

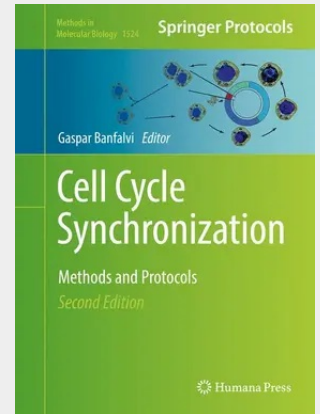
## Cell Cycle Synchronization
