

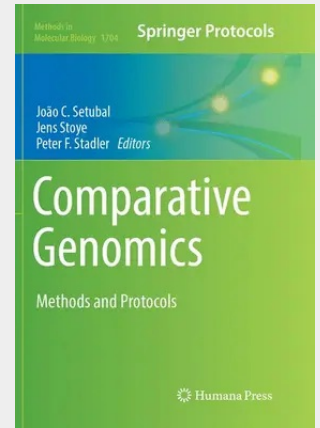
Comparative Genomics
