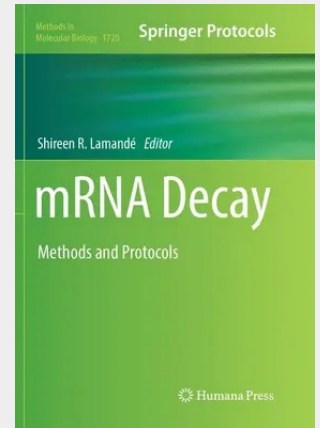
Methods and Protocols
