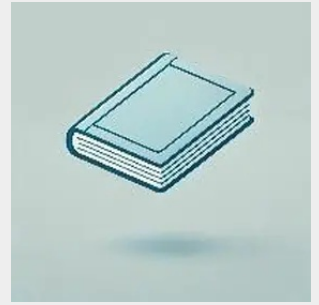


EU Fundamental Rights
