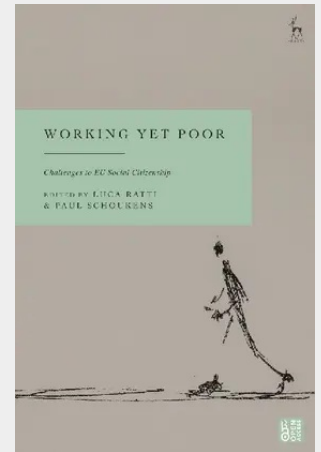


Working Yet Poor
