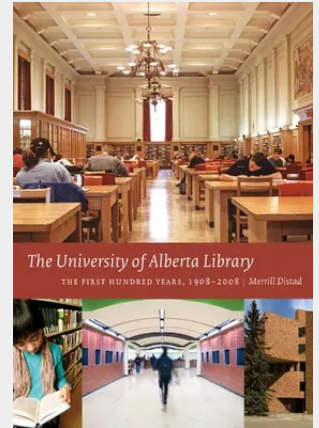


The University of Alberta Library
