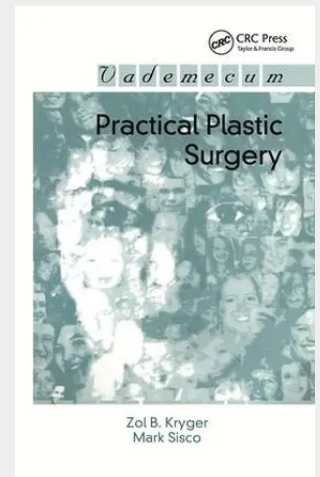


Practical Plastic Surgery
