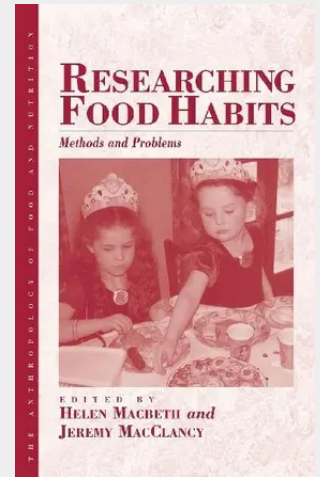


Researching Food Habits
