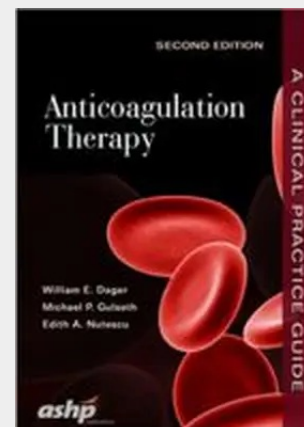


Anticoagulation Therapy
