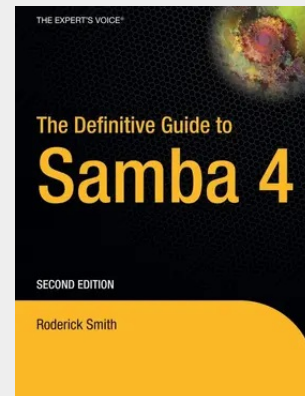


The Definitive Guide to Samba 4
