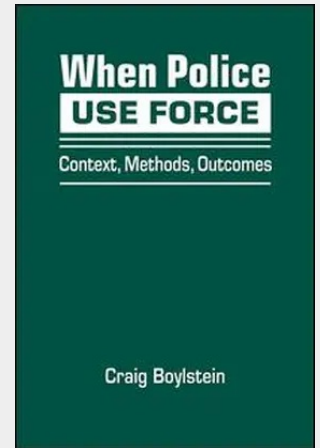


When Police Use Force
