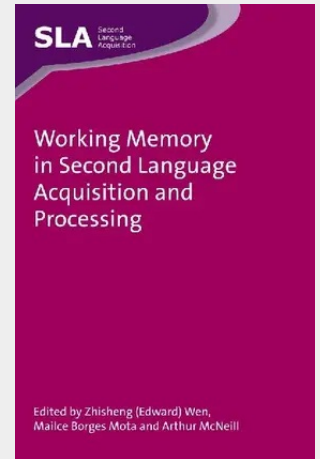


Working Memory in Second Language Acquisition and Processing
