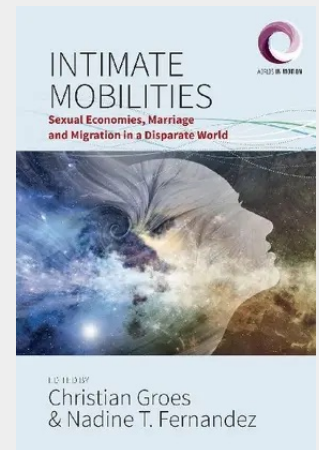


Intimate Mobilities
