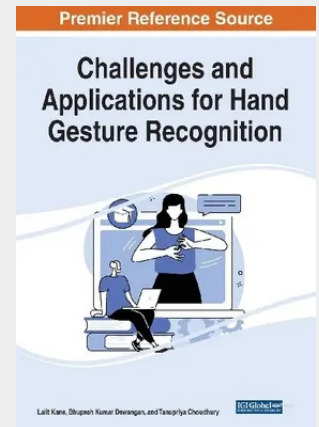


Challenges and Applications for Hand Gesture Recognition
