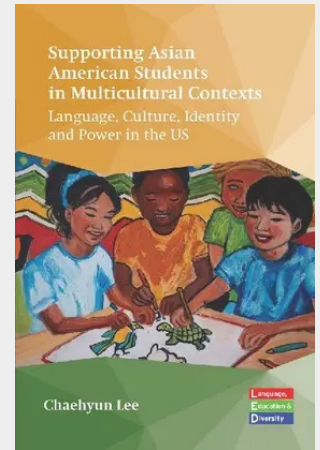


Supporting Asian American Students in Multicultural Contexts
