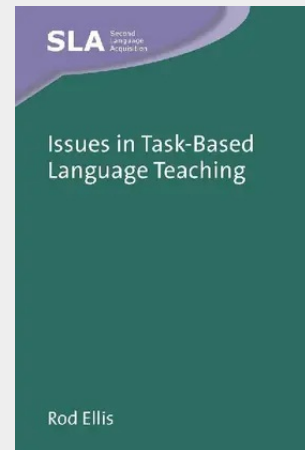


Issues in Task-Based Language Teaching
