

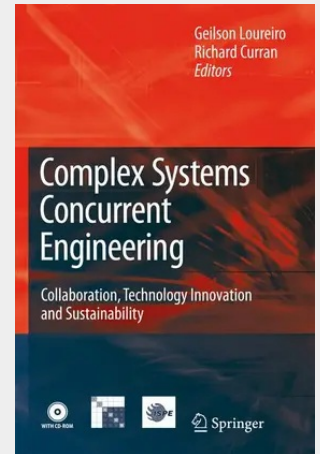
Complex Systems Concurrent Engineering
