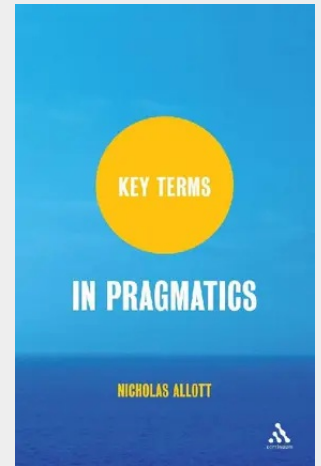


Key Terms in Pragmatics
