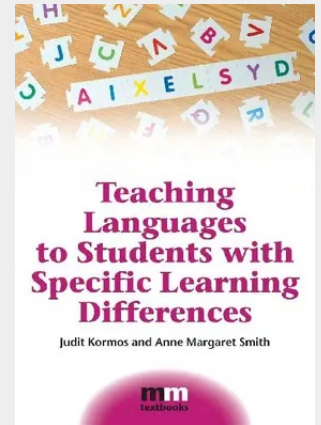


## Teaching Languages to Students with Specific Learning Differences
