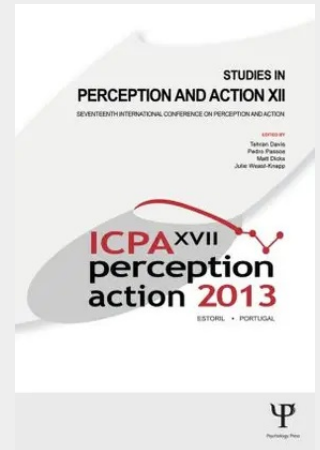


Studies in Perception and Action XII
