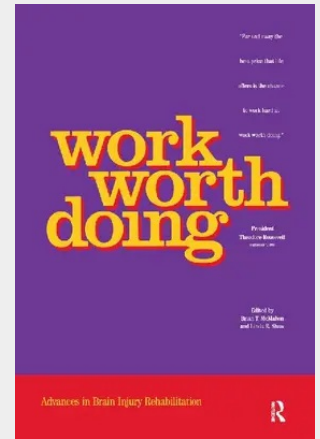


Work Worth Doing
