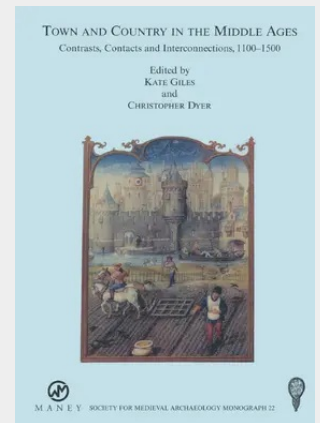


Town and Country in the Middle Ages: Contrasts, Contacts and Interconnections, 1100-1500: No. 22
