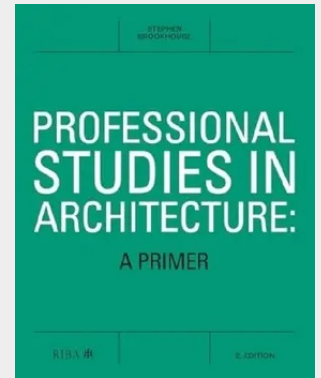


Professional Studies in Architecture
