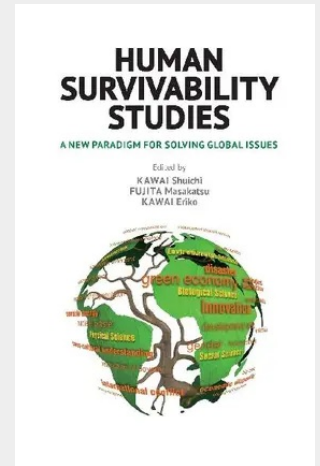


Human Survivability Studies
