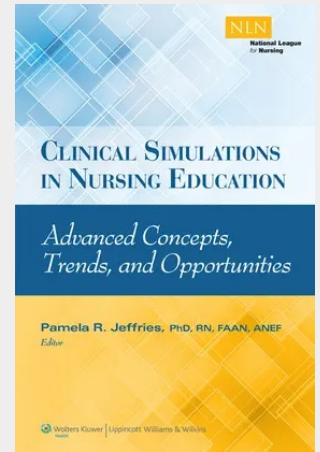


Clinical Simulations in Nursing Education
