

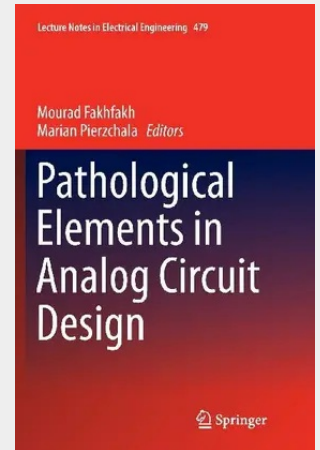
Pathological Elements in Analog Circuit Design
