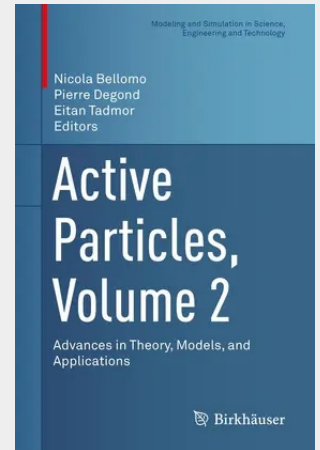
Advances in Theory, Models, and Applications
