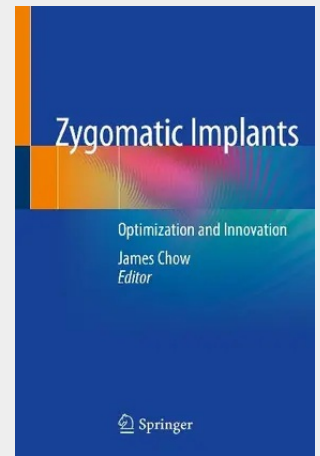


Zygomatic Implants
