

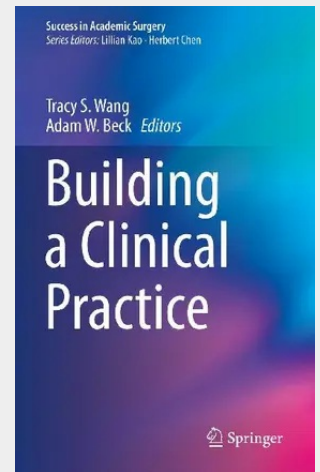
Building a Clinical Practice
