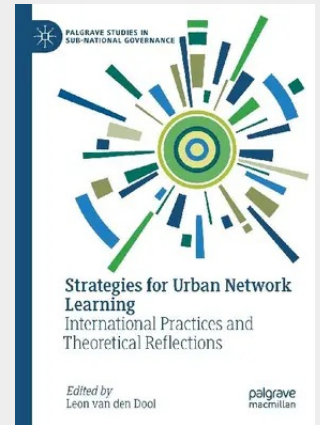


Strategies for Urban Network Learning
