

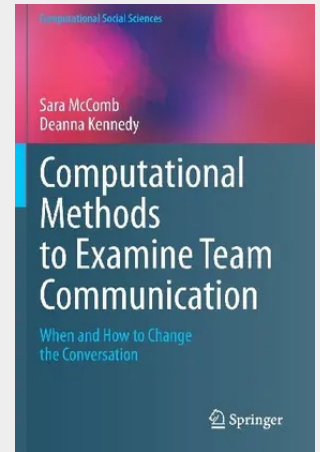
Computational Methods to Examine Team Communication
