

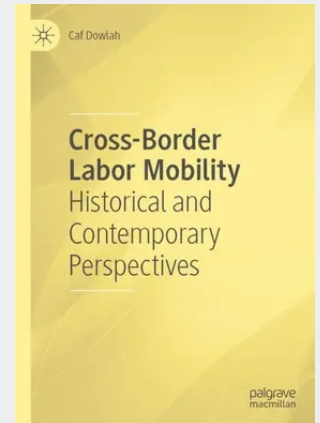
Cross-Border Labor Mobility
