

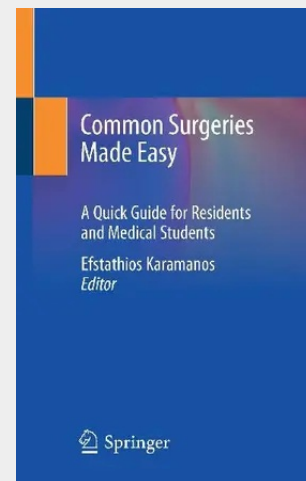
Common Surgeries Made Easy
