

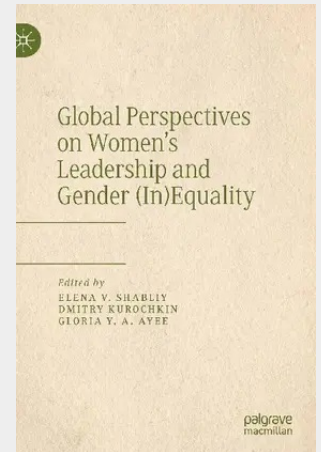
Global Perspectives on Women's Leadership and Gender (In)Equality
