

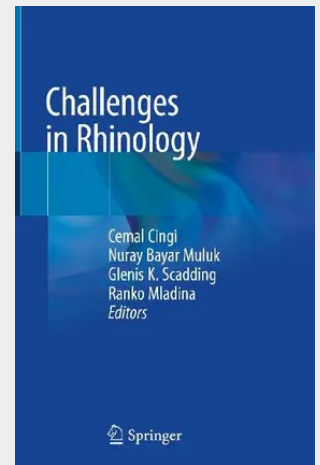
Challenges in Rhinology
