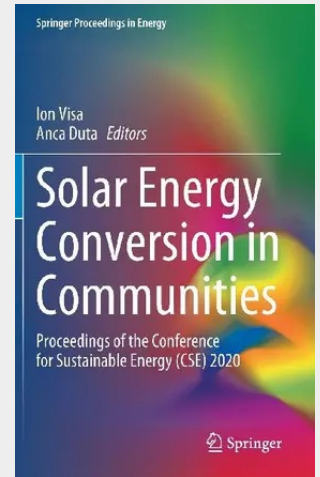


Solar Energy Conversion in Communities
