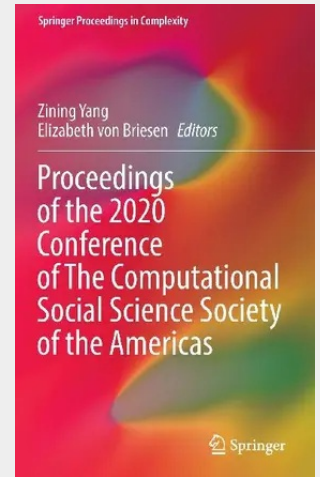


Proceedings of the 2020 Conference of The Computational Social Science Society of the Americas
