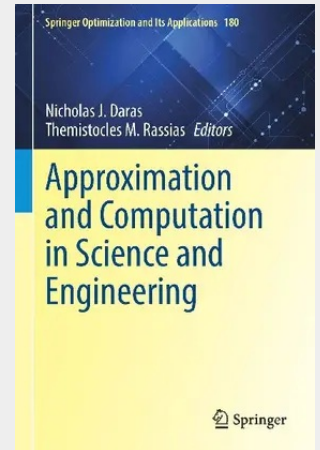


Approximation and Computation in Science and Engineering
