

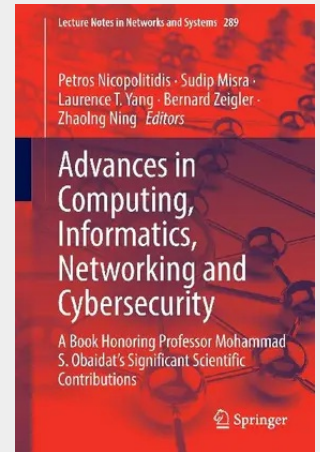
Advances in Computing, Informatics, Networking and Cybersecurity
