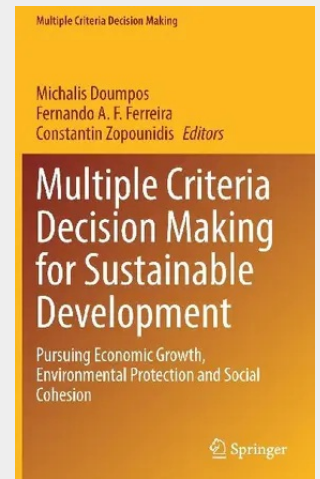


Multiple Criteria Decision Making for Sustainable Development
