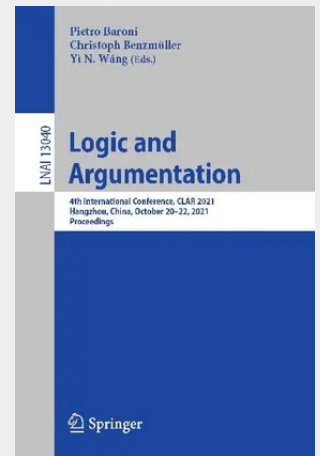


Logic and Argumentation
