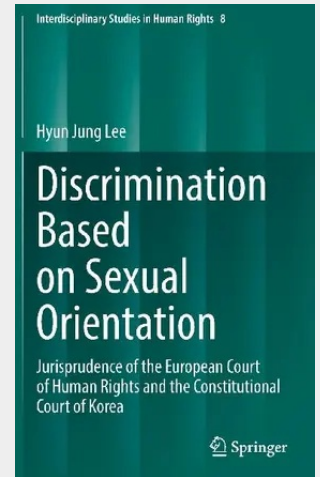


Discrimination Based on Sexual Orientation
