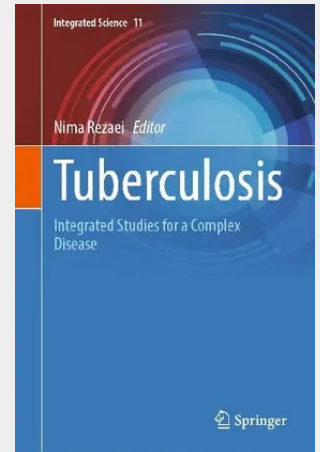


Tuberculosis

In addition, variability in susceptibility to tuberculosis pose a complex problem with numerous interrelated variables.
