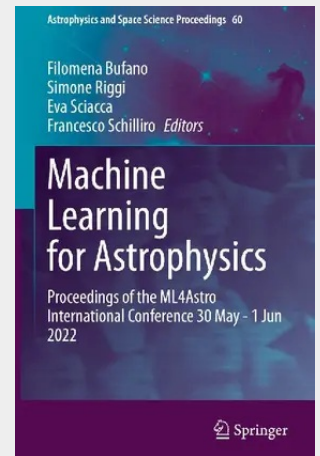


Machine Learning for Astrophysics
