

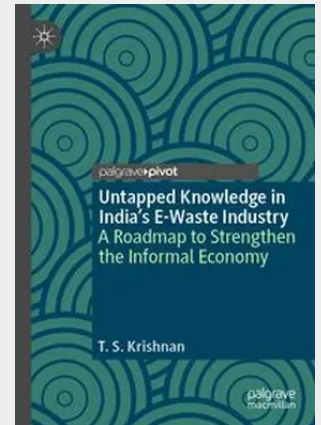
Untapped Knowledge in India's E-Waste Industry
