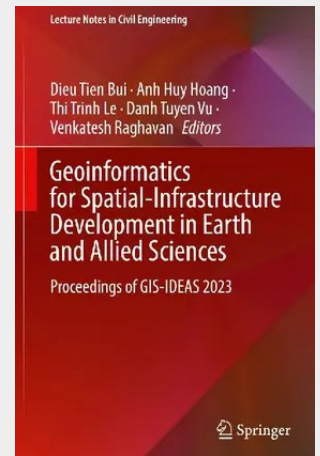


Geoinformatics for Spatial-Infrastructure Development in Earth and Allied Sciences
