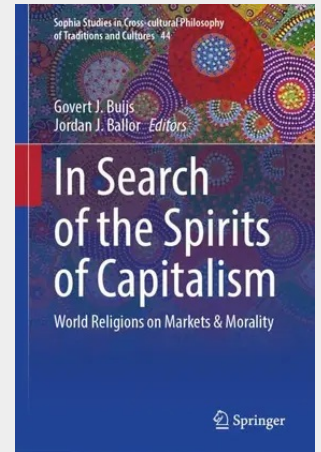


In Search of the Spirits of Capitalism
