

Navigating Complex Research Terrains

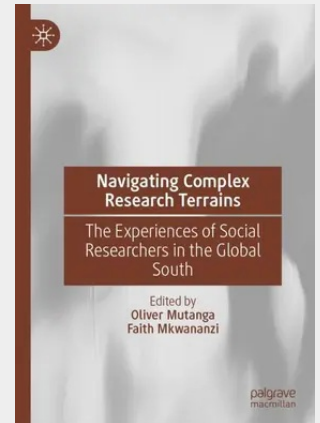
The Experiences of Social Researchers in the Global South
