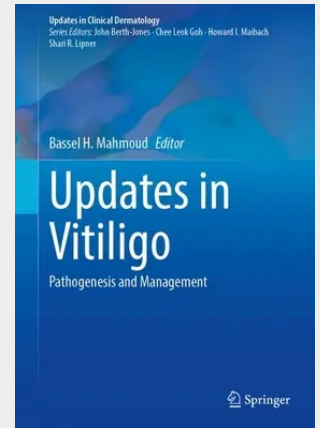
Pathogenesis and Management
