

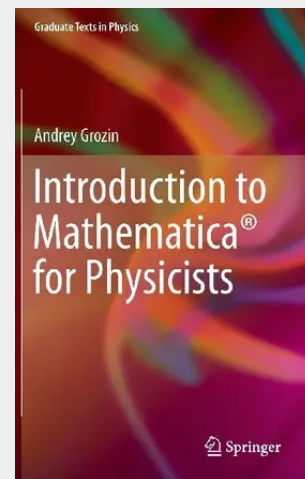
Introduction to Mathematica® for Physicists
